- I also help by linking a patient back into their cancer nurse specialist at WUTH or Clatterbridge.
- The support I can provide can vary from patient to patient. I want to make sure that the patient has a seamless journey from primary to secondary care. I have the ability to understand what patients are going through as I have lived experience as well as Macmillan training.
